TO INCREASE ACCESS TO MASS PUBLICATION NEWSPAPERS

- 1 WHEREAS, the Collegiate Readership Program allows the
2 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board
3 to provide students free access to select newspaper
4 publications;
- 5 WHEREAS, the program offers students the opportunity to learn
6 about issues that span the globe from some of the top
7 national newspaper publications; increasing their
8 status as an educated global citizen;
- 9 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh Student Government
10 Board wishes to continue to provide these services for
11 the undergraduate student body; *now, therefore, be it*
- 12 RESOLVED, on this 19th day of April in the year of 2016, the
13 Student Government Board at the University of
14 Pittsburgh amends Title 8, Chapter 2, Item 1 C of the
15 SGB Governing Code to read: "This Chapter will

16 expire at the conclusion of the Spring 2017 academic
17 term;" *and be it further resolved*

18 RESOLVED, that all numbering changes resulting from these
19 revisions shall be automatic, pursuant to the rules set
20 forth in items 1.1.1.0.4 and 1.1.1.0.5 of the Student
21 Government Board Governing Code; *and be it finally*

22 RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be effective immediately
23 upon adoption and shall reflect the changes shown in
24 the attached document.
