A BILL

TO RENEW THE COLLEGIATE READERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE 2017-2018
SCHOOL YEAR

- 1 WHEREAS, the Collegiate Readership Program allows the
2 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board
3 to provide students free access to select newspaper
4 publications;
- 5 WHEREAS, the program offers students the opportunity to learn
6 about issues that span the globe from some of the top
7 national newspaper publications; increasing their
8 status as an educated global citizen;
- 9 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh Student Government
10 Board can now provide full access to the New York
11 Times online to every non-College of General Studies
12 undergraduate student;
- 13 WHEREAS, for a more environmentally sustainable solution, SGB
14 wants to eliminate paper waste on campus;

15 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh Student Government
16 Board wishes to continue to provide these services
17 digitally for the undergraduate student body; *now,*
18 *therefore, be it*

19 RESOLVED, on this 18th day of April in the year 2017, the Student
20 Government Board at the University of Pittsburgh
21 amends Title 8, Chapter 2, Item 1 C of the SGB
22 Governing Code to read: “This Chapter will expire at
23 the conclusion of the Spring 2018 academic term;” *and*
24 *be it further*

25 RESOLVED, that the following Governing Code revisions be made:
26 “Item 2. Definitions” is deleted.
27 “Item 3. Paper Edition Program Details” becomes
28 “Item 2. Program Details” and reads as follows:
29 “A. Approved newspaper publications will be made
30 available online for the entirety of the non-CGS
31 undergraduate University of Pittsburgh – Pittsburgh
32 Campus population during the academic year.
33 B. The following approved online publications will be
34 made available:
35 1. The New York Times”; *and be it further*

36 RESOLVED, that all numbering changes resulting from these
37 revisions shall be automatic, pursuant to the rules set
38 forth in items 1.1.1.0.4 and 1.1.1.0.5 of the Student
39 Government Board Governing Code; *and be it finally*

40 RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be effective immediately
41 upon adoption and shall reflect the changes shown in
42 the attached document.

43 ADOPTED: this 18th day of April 2017 by a vote of 8 for, 0 against,
44 and 0 abstentions.
