# A BILL

UPDATING THE BYLAWS OF THE ASSEMBLY

- 1 WHEREAS, The Assembly is meant to create a forum of  
2 collaboration and networking among student  
3 organizations on campus;
- 4 WHEREAS, The Bylaws of the Assembly are meant to clearly  
5 outline the purpose and procedures of this legislative  
6 body;
- 7 WHEREAS, The Student Government Board wishes to receive  
8 feedback and concerns from constituents of Assembly  
9 organizations;
- 10 WHEREAS, The Student Government Board wishes to ease the  
11 process of assigning delegates to the Assembly by  
12 member organizations; *now, therefore, be it*

13 RESOLVED, on this 7th day of November in the year 2017, the  
14 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board  
15 suggests the following changes to the Assembly  
16 bylaws:

17

18 Item 6.1.2.1.2.C shall now read: “Alternates may  
19 attend any open meeting when the delegate is present,  
20 but may not vote when the delegate is present.”

21

22 Item 6.1.2.2.1.B shall now read: “Each student  
23 organization will select one delegate by the first day of  
24 the Fall Term, by the method specified in the bylaws of  
25 the student organization.”

26

27 Item 6.1.2.2.1.C shall now read “Terms of delegates  
28 shall begin on the first day of the Fall Term and shall  
29 serve until the next delegate is selected.”

30 Item 6.2.1.2.1.B shall be added and shall read  
31 “Delegates should arrive to each meeting prepared to  
32 deliver updates on their organization and upcoming  
33 events, as well as bring feedback and concerns from  
34 organization constituents.”

35 RESOLVED, that the above changes will be voted on at the next  
36 meeting of the Assembly; *and be it finally*

37 RESOLVED, this resolution shall be effective immediately upon  
38 adoption and shall reflect the official position of the  
39 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board.

40 ADOPTED: this 7<sup>th</sup> day of November 2017 by a vote of 8 for, 0  
41 against, and 0 abstentions.
