## A BILL

TO REVISE STUDENT SERVICES

1 WHEREAS, Student Government Board offers a variety of student  
2 services, including undergraduate conference grants, a  
3 crisis relief fund, student legal services, a collegiate  
4 readership program, and storage and office space for  
5 student organizations;

6 WHEREAS, the nature and purpose of these services evolves  
7 through time to adapt and better serve the  
8 undergraduate student body;

9 WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Conference Fund for Research did  
10 not disburse all available funds the last two years;  
11 *now, therefore, be it*

12 RESOLVED, on this 10th day of April in the year 2018, the  
13 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board  
14 enacts the following revisions to the Student

- 15 Government Board Governing Code under the short  
16 title Student Services:

- 18 Item 8.3.1.B change the word “ten” to “twelve”  
19
- 20 Item 8.4.4.E add “The Chief of Staff reserves the right to commission a  
21 task force to assist in the administration of office  
22 space” to the beginning of the clause  
23
- 24 Remove Item 8.5 “Student Publication Racks”  
25
- 26 Item 8.6.1.C change the word “three” to “five”  
27
- 28 Item 8.6.2.C change both instances of “Travel” to “Conference” *and be*  
29 *it further*
- 30 RESOLVED, that all numbering changes resulting from these  
31 revisions shall be automatic, pursuant to the rules set  
32 forth in items 1.1.1.0.4 and 1.1.1.0.5 of the Student  
33 Government Board Governing Code; *and be it finally*
- 34 RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be effective at the start of the  
35 Fall 2018 semester and shall reflect the changes  
36 shown in the attached document.
- 37 ADOPTED: this 10th day of April 2018 by a vote of 8 for, 0 against,  
38 and 0 abstentions.
