A BILL

CLEARLY DEFINING THE ROLE OF BOARD LIAISONS TO CONDITIONAL
COMMITTEES

- 1 WHEREAS, the Board Member Liaisons to Conditional
2 Committees should serve as the intermediary between
3 their assigned conditional committee members and the
4 rest of the board
- 5 WHEREAS, previously the role and responsibilities of Conditional
6 Committee Liaisons has not been defined in the
7 Student Government Board governing code: *now,*
8 *therefore, be it*
- 9 RESOLVED, on this 10th day of April in the year 2018, the
10 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board
11 enacts the following revisions to the Student
12 Government Board Governing Code:
- 13 Item 2.1.1.0.1.B Add “2. Appoint Board Members as liaisons to
14 standing and conditional committees”.

15 Item 2.1.5.0.2 Create item “2. Duties of Liaisons to Conditional
16 Committees” add sub-sections
17 “A. Board Members acting as Conditional
18 Committee Liaisons shall:”
19 “1. Attend two committee meetings per
20 semester”.
21 “2. Coordinate a monthly meeting with the
22 Chair of the conditional committee the Board
23 Member is assigned to”.
24 RESOLVED, that all numbering changes resulting from these
25 revisions shall be automatic, pursuant to the rules set
26 forth in items 1.1.1.0.4 and 1.1.1.0.5 of the Student
27 Government Board Governing Code; *and be it finally*
28 RESOLVED, that this bill shall be effective immediately upon
29 adoption and shall reflect the changes shown in the
30 attached document.
31 ADOPTED: this 10th day of April 2018 by a vote of 8 for, 0 against,
32 and 0 abstentions.
