TO ALIGN THE GOVERNING CODE WITH THE REVISED CONSTITUTION

5 elections procedures to ensure future elections run
6 smoothly;
7 WHEREAS, the Task Force has made several recommendations for
8 revisions to the Elections Code and Elections
9 Committee bylaws; *now, therefore, be it*
10 RESOLVED, on this 20th day of April in the year 2021, the
11 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board
12 enacts the following revisions to the Student

13 Government Board Governing Code under the short
14 title Elections Procedure Revisions; *and be it further*
