

A JOINT RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
THE PENNSYLVANIA ASSOCIATION OF STATE-RELATED STUDENTS

WHEREAS, the Student Governments of the Pennsylvania State University, University of Pittsburgh, Lincoln University, and Temple University represent the collective interests of 170,000 students, of which 150,000 are Pennsylvania residents;

WHEREAS PASS universities are economic and intellectual drivers in the commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

It is in the best interests of our students now and in the future, to collaborate on issues of mutual concern

WHEREAS the pass schools are concerned about the well-being of these institutions and future access to high quality education; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Student Governments of the Pennsylvania State University, University of Pittsburgh, Lincoln University and Temple University hereby establish the Pennsylvania Association of State-Related Students (PASS) to collectively advocate for our joint interests on Commonwealth issues
