**WHEREAS,** There currently exists a cap on the competition expenses of certified sports and recreation clubs, stating that no organization may receive more than \$5000.00 in a fiscal year for expenses directly related to the competitive aspect of the club.

**WHEREAS,** The Student Government Board of the University of Pittsburgh believes that the aforementioned cap inhibits the ability of the Allocations Committee to formulate a proper recommendation on funding for sports and recreation clubs.

**WHEREAS,** The ability of the Board to adjudicate manners of allocations in a consistent and equitable manner has been impeded by the presence of a cap on competition expenses.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** On this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February, in the year 2009, the Student Government Board of the University of Pittsburgh hereby recommends that the aforementioned Sport and Recreation Cap be revoked, and all allocations of funds to certified sports and recreation clubs be adjudicated in a manner that is consistent with the policies established by the Office of Student Life and Student Government Board.
