A BILL

TO CLARIFY THE DISMISSAL PROCESS & CODE OF ETHICS FOR ALL
MEMBERS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BOARD

- 1 WHEREAS, the Code of Ethics of the Student Government Board of
2 the University of Pittsburgh exists in order to define
3 the expectations of the elected and appointed members
4 of SGB while ensuring proper accountability to the
5 student community;
- 6 WHEREAS, it should be the goal of the Student Government Board
7 to set a campus-wide standard for behavior;
- 8 WHEREAS, the SGB Constitution outlines the dismissal process
9 for the President, Board Members, and Committee
10 Chairs;
- 11 WHEREAS, the President serves as the direct supervisor for all
12 Board Members and Committee Chairs, and
13 Committee Chairs serve as the direct supervisor for
14 their committee members; *now, therefore, be it*
- 15 RESOLVED, on this 17th day of April in the year 2018, the
16 University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board

17 enacts the following revisions to the Student
18 Government Board Governing Code:

20 Item 1.1.2.0.3 amend clause A to read “The President shall be the
21 direct supervisor for all Board Members, Committee Chairs, and
22 members of the Office of the President.

23 Item 1.4.3.0.1B shall be added and read “The direct supervisor shall be
24 notified of any apparent violations of the Code of Ethics by a
25 supervisee.”

26 Item 1.4.3.0.2C shall be revised and read “A public statement listing
27 the Governing Code violations and reasons for dismissal shall be
28 released within two days after the dismissal”.

29 Item 1.5.0.0.2A Add clause 3 which shall read “Conduct themselves in
30 a manner that is becoming of their position, and follow all applicable
31 laws, University policies, and the University of Pittsburgh Student
32 Code of Conduct; *and be it further*

33 RESOLVED, that all numbering changes resulting from these
34 revisions shall be automatic, pursuant to the rules set
35 forth in items 1.1.1.0.4 and 1.1.1.0.5 of the Student
36 Government Board Governing Code; *and be it finally*

37 RESOLVED, that this bill shall be effective immediately upon
38 adoption and shall reflect the changes shown in the
39 attached document.

40 ADOPTED: this 17th day of April 2018 by a vote of 8 for, 0 against,
41 and 0 abstentions.
