Joint Statement on Board Member Resignation

PITTSBURGH, PA (August 10, 2022) - University of Pittsburgh Student Government Board (SGB) President Danielle Floyd received and accepted a letter of resignation from Board Member Celeste Lintz.

Board Member Lintz said: "I am honored to have been elected by the student body, and I am proud of the work I was able to contribute to SGB over this past summer. It is with a heavy heart that I chose to resign due to increased commitments, but I feel this is the best decision for the Board at the time. This year's SGB is poised for a substantial impact on our Pitt Student Body, and I wish them much success with the initiatives planned for the following year."

President Floyd said: "I am saddened to see Celeste leave the organization, and I wish her well in her future pursuits. We appreciate her contributions to our Pitt community, and it is now time to turn our attention towards filling this new vacancy."

Board member vacancies are filled through a vote of the Student Government Board. In the days and weeks to come, President Floyd will outline the schedule and procedures for the appointment process. In order to hold office with Student Government Board, students must meet the following requirements:

- All Student Government Board members must be full-time students in good academic standing, with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5, and not under a judicial hold.

SGB is committed to filling this vacancy in a transparent and open manner. As outlined in the [Governing Code](#), the student body will have the opportunity to voice their opinion and ask questions of each applicant in a series of public interviews.
